

D152/C044	BT reminded the National Committees to propose their related A-Deviations and SNCs as early as possible (IR part 2, paragraph E.2.3) so that they can be included in the version of the documents submitted to relevant procedure.
D152/C045	BT agreed that A-deviations and SNCs are not subject to voting but are elements of the normative text that give information to the standard user on how a standard has to be applied within a particular national territory. They are therefore not to be considered as technical changes. If an NC sees a need for submitting an SNC or A-deviation to a standard that has already been ratified it shall notify the BT. This request from an NC is circulated to BT by correspondence (regular consultation) after which it is published as an Amendment to the standard.
D152/045	BT, clarifying D152/C045, confirmed that, where an NC asks for the introduction of an A-deviation or an SNC to a draft standard that is under vote, the corresponding TC is to assess the request and, if acceptable, to ask BT to allow the inclusion.
